

Project

Background

The Messenger Project is part of the Company's extensive landholding within the Yalgoo greenstone belt located 450 km North of Perth, Western Australia. The project is nearby the prolific Golden Grove Copper/Zinc/Gold Mine, recent high grade drilling at the Emu Gnows Nest project ¹ and Tempest recently announced an extension to the project and drilling program historic high grade Messengers Patch ².

- 2500m drilling program at the Messenger Project expected to finish in mid-March:

 - Wally base metal VMS target
